Please review this important information regarding online instruction for Laveen School District:

- Students participating in online instruction should be using their district-issued Chromebook.
- Students will access the lessons and assignments through Google Classroom.
- Students will have a daily class schedule with live lessons through Google Meet.
- The live lessons will include student engagement opportunities, including the possibility of student-to-student dialogue in small groups.
- The live lessons will be recorded so that students and parents can review them at a later time, if the live scheduled time does not fit the family's schedule.
- Students may be captured in the recorded Google Meet. However, the camera may be turned off on a student's device to prevent this.
- Students are expected to comply with the Technology Acceptable Use Agreement.
- The Distance Learning Overview video is provided to give a broad overview of what the online learning structure will look like.
- Parent orientation videos and resources are provided to assist parents with understanding the expectations for online learning.
- It is important for parents to monitor and support their child's experience with online instruction.
- Utilize the teacher email and help desk for questions and support with online learning.
